THE WEEK

The Bible Week begins with Evening Prayer on Monday and concludes with the Eucharist on Friday morning.

During the three core days of Tuesday – Thursday, the programme includes:

- *Keynote Bible Study*
- *Hour of silent prayer before the Sacrament*
- *Optional afternoon seminars on Biblical themes*
- *Sung Eucharist*
- *Informal late night worship*

A welcome at Walsingham!

At the heart of Walsingham is the proclamation that through Mary's 'yes' to God "the Word became flesh and dwelt among us." In Jesus we have received God's living Word, who comes to us with gifts of mercy and love.

For centuries pilgrims have made their way to 'England's Nazareth' to experience those gifts in a particular way through prayer for forgiveness, healing, consolation and renewal. Here, with Mary, we receive, ponder and treasure God's word to us. Here, with Mary, we strive to respond to God's will. From here, with Mary, we go out to share the gospel.

During this Bible Week we reflect together from study, prayer, worship and stillness on Mary's part in God's plan of Salvation, as revealed in Sacred Scripture.

CHILDREN & YOUNG PEOPLE

In the mornings there will be activities for children and young people, and the opportunity to reflect on the gift and role of Scripture in their own lives.

ACCOMMODATION

Participants in the Week will stay in accommodation in and around the Shrine, or in other parts of the village, depending on numbers. All meals will be provided and, after the evening worship times, there is the Shrine's own Norton Café Bar and the friendly 'locals' to be found in the village!

Many of the rooms are shared accommodation, and pilgrims can say who they would like to share with. There is *limited* single accommodation which will be allocated on a first come first served basis and will incur a single person supplement of £30.

The teaching ministry and worship will take place at the Shrine and in other venues around the Village.

OPTIONAL AFTERNOON SEMINARS

Afternoons during the Bible Week are an opportunity for relaxing around Walsingham or visiting the coast or the beautiful north Norfolk countryside.

For those who wish to, there will be a variety of seminars on Scripture and the Saints.
