No tents? No problem!

This year we have teamed up with Campeazy who can provide high-quality tents and even airbeds, sleeping bags and pillows if required. The best part is they will pitch them for you and have everything ready for your arrival. You don't even have to inflate your airbeds! There will be a onsite team available from Campeazy, throughout the pilgrimage to assist your group during your stay if needed. Your tents will pitched in the Campeazy area. These will need to be booked **in advance** and **separately via their website**:

www.campeazy.com but please remember to book with the Shrine first before booking your tents! Just select 2020 tent hire events and then click on the Walsingham Youth Pilgrimage event. You can then select how many tents you need and add in extras such as airbeds, sleeping bags and pillows. These must be booked by the 1st June to ensure availability.

The Campsite

- A large field; five minutes walk away from the centre of Walsingham
- Big Top Marquee for lively worship and fun events
- Toilet and shower facilities
- No generators are allowed on site, but electric hookups are available for a fee of £100. These must be booked before 1st June 2020



Cost

We are able to offer a fully catered option for groups attending. **This year we are also providing breakfast.** This is ideal for those who do not want to shop, cook and wash up on site! Catering will begin with a BBQ on Monday evening and finish with breakfast on Friday morning.

With full catering (breakfast, lunch and supper): £176 per person (Must be booked by 1st June 2020)

Self catering:

£85 per person if booked by 1st June 2020 £95 per person if booked after 1st June 2020
