

## Description of Relics, Shrine Website Photo Gallery

- 1. S. Valentine, Martyr. Phial reliquary in gilded metal containing tooth relic.
- 2. S. Valentine, Martyr. Part of jawbone. Wooden reliquary-locally made.
- 3a. Gothic chasse reliquary in mediaeval style made by Louis Marcy (Paris, c.1880) in silver with figures of Our Lord and Our Lady, two Bishops (S. Blaise and S. Thomas of Canterbury), two kings (S. Louis and S. Edward the Confessor?), and a relic of S. Benedict, Abbot, in a small silver capsa.

- 4. 18<sup>th</sup> century metal reliquary in the Renaissance style. Relics of S. Emerentiana, Virgin and Martyr; S. Fidelis, martyr; S. Constantine, King and Martyr; S. Benedicta, Virgin and Martyr; and S. Therèse of Lisieux, Virgin.
- 5. 15<sup>th</sup> Century reliquary within gilt copper with a Gothic foliated base, the cross added much later. Relics of S. Wolfgang, Bishop, Confessor; S. Paul of Verdun, Confessor; S. Monica, Widow; S. Hilary, Bishop, Confessor & Doctor; S. George, Martyr; S. Catherine, Virgin and Martyr.
- 6a. 17th Century Italian Renaissance Reliquary with opening doors. 36 relics in all, including all the Apostles, S. Elizabeth, S Anne, S. Laurence, S. Anthony of Padua, S. Stephen, S. Francis of Assisi, S. John the Baptist, S. Paschal Baylon, and many early martyrs.
- 6b. As above.
- 7. Relic Picture, from the Pontificate of Pope Clement XIV (1764-1774) with wax image of Our Lady and 11 relics of early martyrs.
- 8. Oriental Cross containing carved wood, given by Napoleon I to the Empress Josephine. Tertiary relic touched against the wood of the True Cross.
- 9. Late 19th century carved wooden bust reliquary of S. Hugh of Lincoln.
- 10. Renaissance reliquary (one of a pair in the Holy House) in carved wood. Relics of S. Agatha; S. Gregory the Great; S. Paul, Confessor; S. Laurence, Deacon & Martyr; S. Louis, King & Confessor; S. Ursula, Virgin & Martyr; S. Elizabeth of Hungary, Widow; St Anastasia, Virgin & Martyr; S. Pacian, Bishop; S. Urban, Martyr.

- 12. 19<sup>th</sup> arm reliquary in gilded wood. Relic of S. Gregory Nazianzen, Bishop, Confessor & Doctor.
- 13. 19th century gilt metal reliquary with crystal container.
- 14. Second Empire French reliquary in metal. Relic of S. Benedict, Martyr (one of a pair).
- 15. 18<sup>th</sup> century French Baroque reliquary in gilded wood. Relic of S. Maria Goretti, Virgin & Martyr.
- 16. 18<sup>th</sup> Baroque Reliquary in gilded wood. Relics of St Felix, Martyr and S. Generosus, Martyr.
- 17. 20<sup>th</sup> gilt wooden reliquary, silver capsa with relic of S. Anne, Mother of Our Lady.
- 18. 19<sup>th</sup> gilded wooden baroque reliquary with tertiary relics of the Passion. Relics of olive wood from Gethsemane. Stones from the Holy Sepulchre, Via Dolorosa, Bethlehem, Ecce Homo and Gethsemane.
- 19. Second French Empire 'clock' reliquary in gilded wood with 12 relics: Bl. Bernard of Corleone Confessor; S. Joseph Leonessa Confessor; S. Benedict of Urbino Confessor; S. Felix of Cantalice, Confessor; S. Crispin of Viterbo, Confessor; S. Fidelis of Sigmaringen, Martyr; S. Veronica Guiliani,

- Virgin; S. Lawrence of Brindisi, Confessor; Blessed Bernard of Offida, Confessor; S. Seraphinus of Asioli, Confessor; Blessed Angelo of Acri, Confessor; S. Francis of Assisi, Confessor.
- 20. Wooden reliquary, locally made, containing glass phial with Relic of vertebrae of S. Prosper, Martyr.
- 21. Metal reliquary dated 1931, with Relic of S. Anthony of Padua and 7<sup>th</sup> centenary medal.
- 22. Papier-mâché bust reliquary of S. Monica, Widow.
- 23. Papier-mâché bust reliquary of S. Augustine B.C.D.
- 24. Wooden reliquary, locally made, with Relic of the Tree of Martyrdom of S. Edmund, King & Martyr at Hoxne.
- 25. 18th century wooden reliquary (one of a pair). Relics of S. Teresa of Avila and S. Begga, Virgin.
- 26. 18<sup>th</sup> century carved wooden reliquary. Relics of S. Vitalis, Martyr. S. Placidus, Martyr. St Prosperus, Martyr.
- 27. Wooden reliquary, locally made, containing relic of S. Vitalis, Martyr.
- 28. Metal chasse reliquary. Arm bone of S. Vincent, Deacon and Martyr.
