Please read all the information carefully, even if you have been before. There are some changes that you need to be aware of and please make sure you share the information with all your adult leaders and young people. In particular, please check the sections in the information booklet for the following:

- Day Visitors (must produce a DBS certificate on arrival)
- Shrine consent forms **only** will be accepted this year. If you have your own forms, unfortunately these will not be accepted and you will need to complete the Shrine forms as well
- T-Shirts
- · Safeguarding checklist

Please note that **all paperwork must be returned by the dates stated**. As is this a large event and organisation, safety and safeguarding is complex, failure to return all the required forms by the due date may result in your groups place being cancelled and access to the site will be denied. The majority of the paperwork required is contained in the 'Information Booklet', which also contains a handy paperwork checklist to help you return everything on the correct dates.

If you have booked for the catered option, please inform us of any dietary requirements as soon as possible, if you have not done so already.
