Financial Support

If you have young pilgrims in your parish who are unable to attend due to financial constraints, we can offer assistance through our bursary scheme. We are also able to provide grants to help with transport costs for your group. Further details and an application form are available on our website.

Tent Hire

Campeazy provide high-quality tents and even airbeds, sleeping bags and pillows if required. The best part is they will pitch them for you and have everything ready for your arrival. You don't even have to inflate your airbeds! Details will be sent when you book.

Catering Options

We are able to offer a fully catered option for groups attending. This is ideal for those who do not want to shop, cook and wash up on site! Catering will begin with a BBQ on Monday evening and finish with breakfast on Friday morning. Packed lunches to take away on Friday are also available.
