The Walsingham Youth Pilgrimage offers a fantastic five days of worship, bible study and teaching, as well as fun for our teenage pilgrims. Over the years it has changed the lives of countless young people who have never forgotten their week in Walsingham, and many of them have come to love the Shrine and to make the pilgrimage ever since.

2025 Pilgrimage

The 2025 pilgrimage is called 'Credo - Seeing Jesus through Mary's eyes'.

What is a 'creed' and why do we say it?
What does it mean for us to say that 'we believe'?
What does the Creed teach us about Jesus?

We will be exploring these questions and much more during the week as we explore the Nicene Creed - a bold declaration of faith that unites believers around the world and has been passed down through generations since the 4th century.

We need your help
